Chiswick House and Gardens

Hogarth's House, Emery Walker's House, William Morris' Coach House Workshop
and much more along the way!



Chiswick House is the most exquisite example of a Palladian Villa in England and the tour endeavours to bring the 18th century to life through discussion. Taking in along the way Hogarth's House, the history of the houses of Chiswick Mall, St Nicholas' Church and yard, the spot at which the ferry once docked and Chiswick Eyot. Then moving into the Arts and Crafts Era we visit Emery Walker's House and William Morris' Coach House workshop. The day has been carefully arranged to create a combination of inspirational visits put together in a unique package by Interior Designer, Susan Llewellyn. The day ends with supper and drinks.

Agenda for the Day

- 10.15am** Arrive at Chiswick House for entry at 10.30am. Meet outside the front entrance opposite the Great Chertsey Road Gate.
- 11.45am** A walk around the recently restored garden, having some £12.1 million spent on its restoration. These gardens are amongst the most historically important in England and the birthplace of the English landscape movement.
- 1pm-1.45pm** Break for a light lunch in the contemporary café designed by award-winning architects, Caruso St John.
- 2pm** An interactive discussion, questions and answers, as we head to Hogarth's House followed by a walk along Chiswick Mall taking in the history of the houses, before visiting St Nicholas' Church and yard. We will look at where the ferry once docked and see Chiswick Eyot before walking to Emery Walker's House and William Morris' Coach House workshop.
- 6pm** Drinks and supper at The Black Lion Pub, South Black Lion Lane.
