## A special guided tour of historic Whitchurch Silk

Whitchurch Silk Mill is a 19th century water mill that continues to weave English silk fabrics using 19th century machinery. Its peaceful setting by the River Test provides a wonderful backdrop to the Mill.

Our guide will take us to see the original mill wheel and Victorian machinery (some of which is usually in action).

Lunch in the tea rooms is followed by an opportunity to purchase silks directly from the mill – a must for interior designers or keen amateurs alike.
